The role will focus in particular on leveraging past experience in national or international context related to regulation and supervision of offshore hydrocarbon prospection, exploration and production in order to optimise the overall regulatory framework for such activities in the EU as regards health, safety and environment protection (HSE).

The work will be undertaken within the context of the current EU initiatives in the wake of the Deepwater Horizon accident of April 2010 and will entail a review and possible modification of rules and working practices in areas including the Commission's and Member States' administrations' involvement in rules-setting, authorizations, compliance verifications and general supervision of offshore hydrocarbon activities off European shores.

In addition, the expert will provide assistance with standard policy-related tasks relating to the offshore oil sector, such as the preparation of presentations, briefings, responses to stakeholder questions and other documents for both internal Commission use and for external dissemination. S/He will also contribute to the organisation of regular meetings on offshore oil-related topics including the Oil Supply Group and the Berlin Forum.

3. Main qualifications :

Candidates must have a broad knowledge of the HSE regulatory framework for offshore oil activities in one or more European jurisdictions as well as understanding of what constitutes best practices in the offshore industry and HSE administration. Ideally this should be supported by previous involvement with competent Member state authorities.

Proven communication abilities in a high level environment, together with solid drafting skills are essential, ideally in recent positions where such activities constituted an important part of the role. 2. Main areas of responsibility:

Climate change is the most serious environmental problem facing the world, and the EU Emissions Trading System is the cornerstone of EU climate policies to tackle it. The system covers around half of the EU's carbon dioxide emissions, and links with emission-reducing projects around the world carried out through the Kyoto Protocol's project-based mechanisms. Since 2000, the Commission has built up the legal framework for emissions trading in the EU in order to reduce greenhouse gas emissions cost-effectively. Over 10,000 installations in 30 countries are currently participating, and from 2012, all airlines with significant emissions will also be included. The European Parliament and the Council have requested in EU legislation that the Commission make a proposal to include international maritime transport emissions in the EU's reduction commitments if there is no effective agreement in IMO or UNFCCC during 2011 including these emissions in reduction commitments.

We are looking for a highly motivated economist to join the team, preferably with a good knowledge of maritime issues and maritime economics. Her/ his tasks will include working with colleagues and Member States' representatives to ensure that shipping contributes to greenhouse gas reduction commitments in a cost-effective way. These tasks may involve working with colleagues to develop a possible legislative proposal for adoption by the Commission in 2012, and the impact assessment for such a proposal.

He/ she may also contribute to achieving the team's goals in relation to project-based approaches to reducing emissions and their use within the EU Emissions Trading System, the reform such mechanisms and development of possible new mechanisms in the context of the climate regime beyond 2012 and the development of an OECD-wide and ultimately global carbon market.
